#### Historically (1990's)

- § Dept of Ag. inspected Bulls for Breeding.
- § Late 1980's these Bull inspections stopped.
- **§ Linear Scoring replaced Bull Inspections for Limos 1993.**
- § Compulsory for registration in Herdbook.
- § Charolais commenced in 1995, followed by Simmentals.
- § Other Breeds commenced over time.





#### **Historically (late 1990's – 2007)**

- § Data collected from Linear Scoring used in within Breed BLUP evaluations for each breed.
- **§** Normal for animals to be:
  - § Scored on their own
  - § Not Weighed at time of Scoring
  - § Range in age from 5 20 months
- § Typical for level of animals scored to increase close to sale dates.
- § Across Breed Linear Scoring commenced by ICBF 2002
- **§ Handheld Computers also rolled out.**

#### **Historically (Summer 2007)**


- § Agreed to improve 'Quality' of data recorded.
- § Rules drawn up to address quality issues:
  - **§ Weighed**
  - § 150-300 days
  - § In a group of at least 5
- **§ Situation explained to Linear Scorers.**
- § Rules distributed to Breed Societies & Farming Press.
- **§** Website improved to reflect changes.
- § Communication of new approach commenced





2008 - 2010

- § January 2010 GROW Service Launched
- § Scorers managed with monthly reviews.







#### 2008 - 2010

- **§ Weight Recording began to increase.**
- § Numbers of animals being scored decreased.
  - **§** Reasons:
  - § Individual Animals for scoring small herds.
  - § Requirement to weight record & score younger than previously turned some Breeders off.
  - **§** Economic Climate

- **§ Number of Pedigrees Weight Recorded increased by 50%**






