Cooperation in genomic selection

- · INTERBULL, Riga Cromie et al.
 - 1. No cooperation
 - 2. Sharing of information on genotyped animals
 - 3. Bilateral swapping of genotypes
 - 4. Multilateral sharing of genotypes



Objective of the list

To facilitate collaboration between countries on genomic selection:

- Increase the accuracy of national genomic evaluations by increasing the training population
- Avoid/reduce duplication of genotyping and save money
- Important for countries that have genotypes and those planning to genotype



The Plan

- March 2009
- Develop a list of genotyped bulls or with DNA or semen available that could be swapped (in Excel)
 - IRL, ESP, GBR, ITA, BEL, CHE, POL, JPN, AUS, ISR, RSA, NZL (LIC)
- Later expanded to also include populations that may consider swapping in the near future (US & Canada)
- · INTERBULL forum set up



Clarity

- Participation in the list does NOT mean sharing of genotypes
- Swapping of genotypes is done through bilateral agreements between individual countries
- · Participation is open to all





 - Interbull ID, SNP name, Top allele 1, Top allele 2, clustering score



Proposition

- List of genotyped animals can be a useful tool to facilitate collaboration between countries
- Adopt it just as another file routinely updated and distributed by INTERBULL
