

# Organisation Access to Farmers Data

The following are the steps which a herd owner can follow to allow an organisation (Teagasc) access his/her data.

## Logging On


Start-up your Internet browser (e.g. Google Chrome) and enter the ICBF web page address [www.icbf.com](http://www.icbf.com)


