How to Order a Genotype?

Herd-owners can order DNA kits through our self-selection screen by logging into your ICBF Account and selecting 'Services' – 'Genomic Services' – 'Place Order'– 'Genotype Groups'. All the different stages of the order can be tracked using the Genotype tracking screen. Payment can be made using a credit or debit card. Alternatively, you can call ICBF **023 8820452** or email **query@icbf.com**.

Below is a step by step guide on how to order a genotype online.

1. Go to www.icbf.com and login to your ICBF Account using your username and password.



BDGP Requirements

Breeders participating in the Beef Data & Genomics Programme (BDGP) need to fulfil their BDGP requirements before ordering. One of the requirements of the BDGP is for participants to genotype the equivalent to 60% of their reference number in each year of the programme.
