


UPDATE – for period 1st - 7th December 2007

1 Database Update





- 4 365,222 inseminations have been received so far in 2007 from the AI handheld, compared with 163,847 in 2006 for the same period.
- ♣ Preparations are continuing in order to be ready for the commencement of the Suckler Cow Welfare Scheme.
 Developments and changes to a number of screens and forms are underway.
- ♣ Production of the personalised farmer notebooks for the 2008 season from the database are continuing, with the further batches going to farmers this week.
- **♣** The implementation of the new hardware solution and database upgrade is taking place this weekend. As previously mentioned, **please note that all systems are down until Tuesday morning @ 9am**.
- Further work took place this week on the Sire Advice solution in advance of the spring breeding season.

2 Tully

- 4 A total of 51 bulls have entered Tully and pre entry isolation for the December intake.
- ♣ A final list of bulls that entered Tully and their EBI indexes will be sent out to breed societies next week.
- ♣ The next IBR test of the bulls in Tully and pre entry isolation will take place on the 11-12-07.

3 G€N€IR€LAND

- ♣ Preparation is underway for the Spring 2008 programme. The list of bulls put forward by the participating AI Companies is available on the ICBF website. Note: not all these bulls will be going in the programme.
- ♣ New web-screens are being designed for both herd-owners and AI companies (incl Field Staff). This will ensure all parties have direct access to data that is relevant to their involvement in the programme.

4 Genetic Evaluations

- ♣ A new calving performance evaluation has been completed using the new MIX99 software. The new software facilitates the incorporation of parities >5 and also is an Animal Model which replaces the previous Sire-Mgs model.
- ☐ These proofs will be used in the January 2008 dairy (EBI) and beef (SBV) index updates.
- Files for the upcoming December INTERBULL evaluations were forwarded to INTERBULL ahead of next Tuesdays deadline.


