


### 1 Important Dates

#### 2 Database

- The stats below are compiled with the assistance of DAFF AIM systems.
- In the Suckler scheme, the number of 2010 born calves with meal introduced is 542,973 with the number of animals weaned at 431,100.
- ♣ The generation of a '5 Year Trend' report for suckler herds is currently underway. This will be distributed to all Suckler Scheme participants in the second half of January as part of the distribution of the 2011 Notebooks and return envelopes.
- The design of a new infrastructure to manage genotypes at ICBF has been largely completed and testing/tweaking of the solution will take place over the coming weeks.




- The building of the solution to allow farmers avail of the genotyping service has been completed and is currently being tested. It will be launched at the Herdplus/G€n€

- ♣ Genetic parameter estimation between carcass cut weights and existing traits in the beef performance evaluation have commenced with a view to potentially including the carcass cut traits as part of the routine evaluation in 2011.
