








- ♣ The stats above are compiled with the assistance of DAFM AIM systems.
- ♣ In the Suckler scheme, the number of 2012 born calves with meal introduced is 457,296, with the number of animals weaned at 281,924.
- **♣** BVD test results continue to be received at ICBF and are being processed accordingly. Around 585,000 tissue tags for BVD testing have been purchased at this stage. Around 460,000 samples have been returned at this stage, with a 0.62% BVD Virus Positive rate.
- Good progress continues around the design of the Beef HerdPlus outputs to incorporate the new Euro-Star indexes, and the development work on these is continuing.
- ♣ The first of the 2013 Dairy personalised notebooks have been generated and printed.
- Weight recording figures dropped significantly this week, down to 731 animals, from 1800 the previous week. We did, however, have 1400 DIY weights recorded by farmers this week.
- The graph shows Inseminations recorded on AI Handhelds in 2012 compared with 2011.



3 Beef Herd-book Meeting

Following on from a very productive Industry meeting last week, representatives from the Beef Herd-books visited ICBF yesterday for a workshop. The workshop was focused on how we can best deal with the common issues we face, and best utilise the collective resources to address them. It was a very constructive meeting.







One of the items discussed was around ICBF plans and priorities for 2013, in relation to beef breeding. A subset of those items includes:

- Promotion of the new \(\partial\text{uro-Stars Indexes.}\)
- Data Quality Index.
- Genomics.
- ICBF role in National BVD Programme.
- Interbeef.
- Increase weight recording/linear scoring.


