





- **4** The stats above are compiled with the assistance of DAFM AIM systems.
- In the Suckler scheme, the number of 2011 born calves with meal introduced is 645,078 with the number of animals weaned at 585,733.
- **WD** test results continue to be received at ICBF and are being processed accordingly. Around 580,000 tissue tags for BVD testing have been purchased at this stage. Around 424,000 samples have been returned at this stage, with a 0.62% BVD Virus Positive rate.
- 4 The 2011/2012 Dairy and Beef calving reports have been run, and should be available in the coming week.
- The Co-Op performance Reports have been run and are currently being posted and are also available online.
- A significant amount of work continues on the modification of systems to incorporate proposed changes to the Beef EuroStar indexes.
- Work is continuing on the back-end ICBF web infrastructure with a view to making it more standardised and robust.
- The graph shows Inseminations recorded on AI Handhelds in 2012compared with 2011.



3 Genetic Evaluations

Routine evaluations are almost complete and loading of proofs to the database is on-going. Once complete a new genomic evaluation will be done for all dairy animals. Official publication of proofs is Monday 20th August.
