




2 Database





- ♣ The stats above are compiled with the assistance of DAFF AIM systems.
- ♣ In the Suckler scheme, the number of 2010 born calves with meal introduced is 599,104 with the number of animals weaned at 525,145.
- Work on the Farm Relief Services (FRS) project continued this week. The project will involve hoof-care operators using handhelds to record the visit data and farmers will subsequently receive reports generated from the ICBF database.
- 4 'Sire Error' reports from the spring calving season have been sent out this week, and will continue to go out over the next week.
- ♣ The first of the fertility report batches were generated this week.
- Work is on-going in establishing electronic links to the commercial animal health laboratories. The first meeting of the BVD implementation group will take place next week.
- ♣ Further refinements to the process of loading genotypes to the database are underway with a view to streamlining the process further.
