





- ♣ The stats above are compiled with the assistance of DAFF AIM systems.
- ♣ In the Suckler scheme, the number of 2009 born calves with meal introduced is 629,131 with the number of animals weaned at 558,978.
- ♣ The usage of the new VET infrastructure is continuing to pick up. All Vets who were already using the ICBF system have been migrated to the new infrastructure. Any Vets wishing to begin interacting with the AHI/ICBF system can register at http://www.animalhealthireland.ie/registerpage.php.
- The development of a new classification report for IHFA is ongoing.
- Updates to the Grow report (beef linear scoring) to include the sending of genetic evaluations are complete. The first of the new reports went out this week and we are awaiting feedback.
