2 Breeding Information Service Proposal

The Chairman (John O'Sullivan), Vice Chairman (Derek Deane) and Chief Executive (Brian Wickham) met with the Pedigree Cattle Breeders Council on Thursday this week.

- → John spoke of the challenges that farmers will face if milk and meat prices decline in the near future. He emphasized that the organizations providing services to farmers can expect to find both the cost and the value of their services being closely examined. John also assured the herd books that ICBF has no intention, or desire, to take over their functions.
- Derek spoke as a beef producer and explained that what he wanted was good information and excellent quality cattle so that he could run a profitable farm.
- ♣ Brian gave a presentation covering the background to the proposal, the issues that need to be considered and outlined a way forward. His presentation identified a number of opportunities for providing new and improved information services to farmers. These services are made possible by a combination of the ICBF database and new information technologies. It also identified the large number of herds and cattle not currently enjoying the benefits of better breeding information.

3 Al Promotion 2006

Plans for a major promotion of the use of AI in spring 2006 are advancing. This promotion is being planned as a joint effort involving AI organisations, TEAGASC, ICBF and DAF. Details of the plan are under active consideration by a working group representing the industry.

4 Tully

- ♣ The final weighing of the bulls for sale on 4th March took place on Tuesday (13th Feb) this week. The performance figures from Tully have been compiled and will be in the catalogue for the Open Day tomorrow.
- ♣ The final catalogue for the sale on 4th March will be on the ICBF web site from the 22nd February.
- ♣ The bulls for sale will be TB tested on the 21st February with the results read on 24th Feb.
- ♣ An Open Day will be held at Tully tomorrow. All are welcome.

5 Genetic Evaluations – Beef & Dairy

- ♣ Processing of proofs for the next release of Dairy evaluations is nearing completion. Proofs will be released to the industry on Monday next week.
- 4 A new beef evaluation incorporating the data from the current Tully Intake has been completed. The latest indexes for Tully bulls will be available at the Tully Open day on Saturday.
- New linear beef type trait evaluations were released to the industry for feedback. In light of some feedback work is continuing on the improvement of these proofs. Further feedback is welcomed.



- **SWS.** Recruitment proceeding with over 50 herds now signed up. Technician hired and initial training underway first herds recorded this week.
