



2 Tully

- ♣ Currently bulls are having their concentrate offering increased gradually so as to ensure all bulls are on ad-lib concentrates prior to the start of their performance test. The performance test will start on Monday 27th June. The test will last for 90 days and will finish at the start of October.
- ♣ Bulls are being washed at present to help maintain and promote hair growth. They are also being treated with a product called tactic at the time of washing, which treats and discourages external parasites such as lice and mange.
- **B**ulls had the second of their three weekly blood samples testing for IBR today. The first two weekly blood samples have come back clear for IBR for all bulls.
- ♣ Next week, all bulls will have two blood samples taken for Genomics research work.
- 4 A Tully Advisory Committee meeting is scheduled for Monday 25th July and will run from 10.00am to 2.00pm. The meeting will take place at Tully and cover a number of topics such as the previous and current intake of bulls and the role of Tully going forward.

- ♣ In the Suckler scheme, the number of 2010 born calves with meal introduced is 613,334 with the number of animals weaned at 547,224.
- Weight recording forms are being distributed to all Herdplus Beef herds today.







A number of updates have been made to the weight recording screens and outputs this week, with a view to streamlining the existing process.

- Work began this week on the upgrade of our reporting infrastructure (Streamserve). This will be a significant piece of work taking place over the coming months. The existing version is no longer supported by the supplier.
- Work is on-going in establishing electronic links to the commercial animal health laboratories. A number of meetings will take place with individual labs next week.
- ♣ The DEP scheme recording sheet and web screens have now been completed. DAFF will be launching the 'health recording' phase of the scheme over the coming weeks.
- ♣ The table shows the % of first inseminations by breed of sire to dairy cows in 2011.
