










- ♣ The stats above are compiled with the assistance of DAFF AIM systems.
- ♣ In the Suckler scheme, the number of 2010 born calves with meal introduced is 577,321 with the number of animals weaned at 491,268.
- As the newly launched genotyping process progresses, on-going development tweaks are being carried out. The first farmer requests were processed this week.
- Further development on the outputs for farmers and AI companies of Genomic EBI results are on-going.
- **4** Testing on a new authorisation module for farmers and their service providers is on-going. This will give

farmers more flexibility and control in providing authorisation to others to see their data.

- Development of a new 'Weight Profile' is continuing. It will link up with the Teagasc Better Farms data collection process, but will also be available to all beef farmers.
- Work continues with AHI on the integration of laboratory health test results to the ICBF database.
