






3 Database Update

- 142 new herds added to the database last week.
- PG, Dovea, and Kerry continue to make progress. In the region of 14,000 inseminations have now been captured across around 75 handhelds.
- Development work to support the back end activities of the AI handheld are continuing, including reporting, and billing functions, for both PG and Dovea and Kerry.
- All breeding charts have been printed and the distribution is almost complete
- The sire advice reports have been distributed
- The development of Fertility Reports for the coming AI season is continuing, and it is hoped that next week, the first of those reports will be generated based on data received through the AI handhelds and through online and email recording. See attached example.





- The 2005 ICBF Statistics have been completed and will be available on the website next week.
- An updated preliminary Tully catalogue with BLUPS is available on the website

4 Genetic Evaluations

- Evaluations for the May run are on-going with files currently being processed for Interbull. The deadline for submission of these new files to Interbull is next Tuesday.
- The latest Tully intake has been completed and this data will be included in a new evaluation which will form the basis of the next Tully sale on Saturday 6th May.
- Sire advice has been run for several hundred herds and reports were distributed to those herds during the week.

5 G€N€ IR€LAND[®]

- Inbreeding charts continue to be compiled and distributed for herds involved in the Dairy G€N€ IR€LAND[®] program.
- Semen from the third group of 10 bulls has been assembled and is currently being dispatched.





• Sign up of herds to the program is starting to wind down. To-date 425 herds have been signed up and the sign up of herds will continue for another couple of weeks.

6 Tully

- The final BLUP figures for the bulls for sale on the 6-5-06 are up on the ICBF web site. The final EBI figures will be up on the ICBF web site from the 26-4-06.
- Inspection of bulls for the May intake will begin on the 25-4-06 and health testing will take place from the 15-5-06.
- A group of suckler farmers from Cavan will visit Tully on the 26-4-06.
- Judging of the FBD prize winners will take place on the 2-5-06 and not the 25-4-06.


