




Sheep 2010, Lyons Estate, UCD – Saturday 26th June. This is a major day for the Irish Sheep industry.

2. Database





- ♣ The stats above are compiled with the assistance of DAFF AIM systems.
- ♣ In the Suckler scheme, the number of 2009 born calves with meal introduced is 632,131 with the number of animals weaned at 564,978.
- We got some further feedback this week on the AHI BVD solution, which we will incorporate in the coming weeks. Any Vets wishing to begin interacting with the AHI/ICBF system can register at http://www.animalhealthireland.ie/registerpage.php.
- ♣ The development of a new classification report for IHFA is now completed and ready for testing.
- A new call logging system for herd-books to use was presented at the weekly herdbook webinar, and will help provide improved transparency on the status of requests from herdbooks.
- Updates have been made to the loading of animal events where the sire of a calf is now checked against AI records in order to provide a further quality check on the data, where possible.

3. Sheep Ireland

- ♣ MALP lambs continue to be EID tagged and weighed at 40 days; all weights are recorded electronically through handhelds and sent directly to the Sheep Ireland Database in Bandon.
- ◆ Over 3800 lambs have been recorded on the Sheep Ireland Database so far this year. LambPlus breeders, who still have to enter their Lambing and 40 Day Weight data, should do so straight away. These breeders will be contacted again in the coming week.
- ♣ Breeders should contact Donegal Farm Relief Service (074-9145386), to organise ultra sound scanning for fat and muscle depth to be carried on their Lambs at 120 to 140 days old.

4. Genetic Evaluations

- ♣ Work is continuing on various improvements to the genetic evaluations.
- ♣ The monthly beef linear evaluations are underway.
- ♣ A Master's project between UCD and ICBF looking at the genetics of twinning in Irish dairy and beef herds has begun.
