




1 Important Dates

- September 27th to 30th Ploughing. HerdPlus will be the main focus of the ICBF stand.
- New Date Wednesday 18th October Beef Breeding Consultation meeting
- Wednesday 11th October Dairy Genetic Evaluation Consultation meeting Moorepark.

2 Database Update

- 23 new herds added to the database last week.
- The number of inseminations recorded on handhelds this year now stands at 153,466..
- 31 Dairygold technicians have now recorded live inseminations. The current plan remains to have all Dairygold technicians currently working live by the end of September.
- Progressive Genetics are also making good progress in cleaning up the data before going live with the North East technicians. It is expected that the training of these technicians will begin in early October, with all technicians up and running by November 1st.
- The linear scoring of dairy progeny test heifers has continued this week, 780 progeny test heifers have now been scored.
- The commercial beef scoring project also kicked off continued this week, with 854 animals now scored.
- The commercial scoring report will be issued to all herds scored to date on Monday. A copy will be included in next weeks update.






3 Tully
