

2 Database Update



- 283,401 inseminations have been received so far in 2008, compared with 197,581 in 2007 for the same period. We have made solid progress in resolving the communication issues between the handhelds and the database.
- Over 370,000 birth registrations from <u>new</u> Animal Events users have been received as part of the Suckler Scheme.
- A second batch of the 'Pre-Weaning' forms went out this week. Further batches will go out next week, along with another batch of Sire Errors.
- Good progress was made this week in setting up the infrastructure for the joint 'Benchmarking Project' being undertaken with Teagasc. The initial phase will focus on KPI's around milk solids output per cow and per hectare.
- Work on enhancing the EBI profiles for HerdPlus users is on-going.
- A re-designed linear scoring and weight recording report is under development and will be completed over the next couple of weeks.

6 G€N€Ireland


