

2 Database Update



- 4 197,004 inseminations have been received so far in 2007, compared with 74,610 for the same period last year.
- A meeting with the AI organisations has been tentatively scheduled for June 20th to do a review of how the handhelds have performed this season and to plan any updates that the technicians/AI staff might see as beneficial.
- **♣** The Teagasc Calving discussion group report was put live this week.

3 Genetic Evaluations

Dairy Genetic evaluations

The EBI proofs for May 07 are now officially available. The bull files have been updated on the website as is the bull search.

There are a couple of points of difference to note from the provisional proofs to the official proofs:

- 1) Gestation Length and reliabilities are from the Feb 07 run due to a problem identified with the current proofs. The other calving performance traits are not affected.
- 2) The calving interval for some foreign bulls has changed. Incorrect calving interval figures were used in the provisional run and these have now been corrected.

↓ Tool have been developed using Excel spreadsheet to allow user, after typing in the French breeding value of an animal, to read the converted proofs in the Irish scale (May 2007) as well as an estimation of the economic indexes Calving traits, weanling export, beef carcass, replacement milk and fertility, replacement calf quality and the relevant €uro-stars rating. This exercise has been done for Charolais & Limousine and is being tested at the moment.


