




2 Database Update





- 4 74,750 inseminations have been received so far in 2007, compared with 25,769 in 2006 for the same period. Farmers are continuing to respond very favorably to the inbreeding functionality the handheld provides.
- The use of the Sire Advice program is on-going at the rate of around 100 'Sire Advice runs' per day. Those herds operating on a technician service have had the results of the Sire Advice loaded to the AI handhelds, where the herd owner had indicated that this was to be the case.
- ♣ Some tweaks to the new Herdbook front end are continuing and further iteration of the facility will be issued next week. Good progress has been made on a number of the tasks arising out of the recent meeting with the Herdbooks.
- ♣ The new season fertility reports are being generated, and are being issued to HerdPlus members see the HerdPlus section for a sample report.
- Some further refinements are being made to the €urostar catalogue for beef herdbooks this week and these are now undergoing final testing.

3 Genetic Evaluations

Dairy Genetic evaluations

- Milk production evaluation has been completed and files are being prepared for submission to Interbull next week (Tue 2nd). These are due back on 14th May and an official publication date will be advised next week.
- ♣ Linear type evaluations for Hol-Fr have been completed.
- Transfer of the calving interval and survival evaluation from Lelystad to ICBF is almost complete. New files will be prepared and submitted to Interbull next week.
- 4 A new calving performance evaluation is currently being run for inclusion in the next EBI run





Beef Genetic Evaluations

- ♣ A new calving performance evaluation is currently being run for all breeds.
- ♣ Beef extracts have been completed and a new beef performance evaluation and linear evaluation will commence early next week.
- **↓** Work on constructing €urostar indexes from French proofs was undertaken. This work is necessary to allow the calculation of Irish indexes for young French born Limousin and Charolais bulls.

5 Tully

- 4 63 bulls were sent to the factory on Thursday with the remainder scheduled for next week. Half from the March intake and half from the May intake.
- ♣ Bulls will be exported to Italy on Monday and 3 bulls will also go to Scotland on Tuesday.
- 49 survey responses have been received from bull owners. These show a strong desire for Tully to continue. We greatly appreciate the time taken by bull owners to give us their opinions. All opinions are being taken into account in deciding on the future operation of Tully.
- 4 A meeting was held on Tuesday to obtain expert advice on the best strategy for reducing the risk of a future outbreak of IBR. The conclusion reached was that the risk could be substantially reduced with the key steps being the introduction of improved protocols (covering biosecurity, enhanced testing, etc) at all herds of origin, at isolation facilities prior to entry to Tully, and at Tully itself.
- 4 A discussion paper on the future of Tully has been prepared for consideration by the Board of ICBF.

6 Gene Ireland

- ♣ Signing up of dairy herds is winding down. We now have a total of 667 herds participating in this springs dairy programme.
- Last week there was a backlog of herds for semen dispatch but after a busy week in the Mallow Lab we are almost back on track.
- There are currently 136 herds for which semen has yet to be packed and dispatched.




♣ To date 30 bulls have had their quota of straws sent out to farmers.




