






1. Important Dates



2. Database





- ♣ The stats above are compiled with the assistance of DAFF AIM systems.
- ♣ In the Suckler scheme, the number of 2010 born calves with meal introduced is 156,922 with the number of animals weaned at 12,030.
- ♣ All batches of Suckler pre-wean forms for 2010 have been sent out to farmers.
- Work is continuing on the design of the new catalogue service for both beef and dairy animals.
- Vets wishing to begin interacting with the AHI/ICBF system can register at http://www.animalhealthireland.ie/registerpage.php.
- Work on a new Dairy Replacements discussion group report is almost complete with testing taking place this week.
- ♣ The Beef Calving reports are currently being run.
- Work is ongoing on the window server infrastructure, involving a move to a more resilient infrastructure for email, file servers, etc.
- Work on a new infrastructure for communicating with marts is on-going, with a view to getting the data flows on a more efficient and effective basis.

- Breeders who have not returned their declaration of interest forms for rams to enter the CPT are urged to do so straight away.
- LambPlus breeders who have matings completed on farm should submit the data to avoid errors and reduce the recording workload at a later stage.

4. Genetic Evaluations

- Official proofs were published on Monday for dairy and beef cattle. Correlations were high with changes primarily due to the addition of more information.
- Work is now focused on improvements to fertility, calving performance and other evaluation that were discussed at the last dairy and beef industry meetings.
