



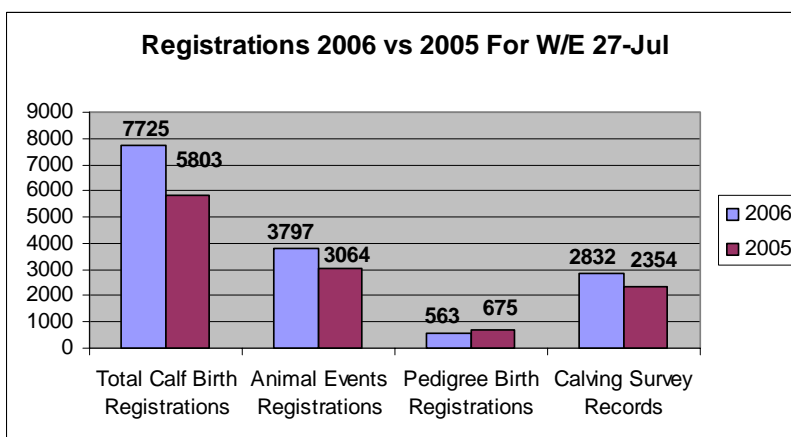
## Update for period 22<sup>nd</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> July 2006

### 1 Important Dates

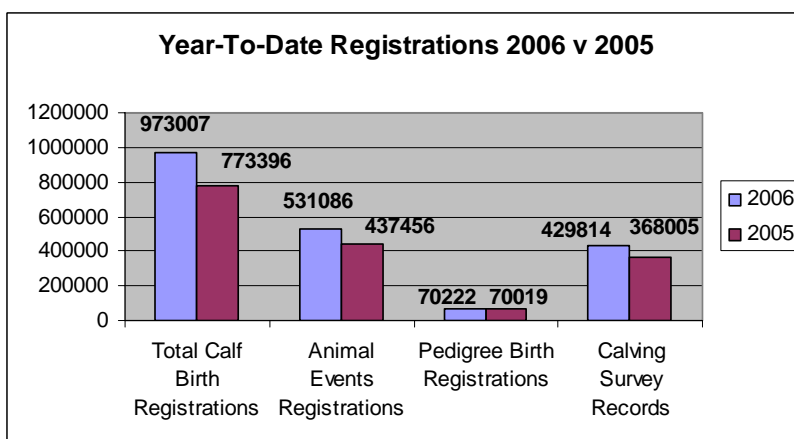
- ✚ **Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> August**, 10.30- 16.00, **Beef Genetic Evaluation Consultation Meeting**, Abbeyleix Manor Hotel. Agenda includes presentation of a proposal for a new linear scoring and weight recording service.
- ✚ **Wednesday 13th September** – EBI €100 Open Day – near Birr.
- ✚ **September 27th to 30th. Ploughing.** The new breeding information service will be the main focus of the ICBF stand.

### 2 Database Update

- ✚ 23 new herds added to the database last week.
- ✚ The 135,000 inseminations mark has now been broken by those technicians using handhelds.
- ✚ Dairygold have taken further technicians live with the AI Handeld this week, and this process will continue over the coming months.



- ✚ Extracts were done this week to provide the basis for the planned commercial beef weanling scoring project.
- ✚ Work to update the ICBF.com website continued this week. It is intended that an updated look to the site will be applied next week.



- ✚ Web development work continues with a focus continuing on building the authorisations around the new breeding information service.

- ✚ The redesign of a number of the current reports (EBI, Calving, Expected Calving) is underway and these changes will be incorporated into the reports before they are released again.

- ✚ Next week will see the finalisation of the design of the application to support the dairy and beef breeding schemes.

### 3 Tully

- ✚ A total of 950 application forms for the next intake (September 2006) have been sent out. Closing date for receipt of applications is 11<sup>th</sup> August 2006. The entry date is before 29<sup>th</sup> September 2006.
- ✚ A catalogue of the May intake of bulls will be up on the ICBF Web site on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2006.

#### 6 Genetic Evaluations - Dairy

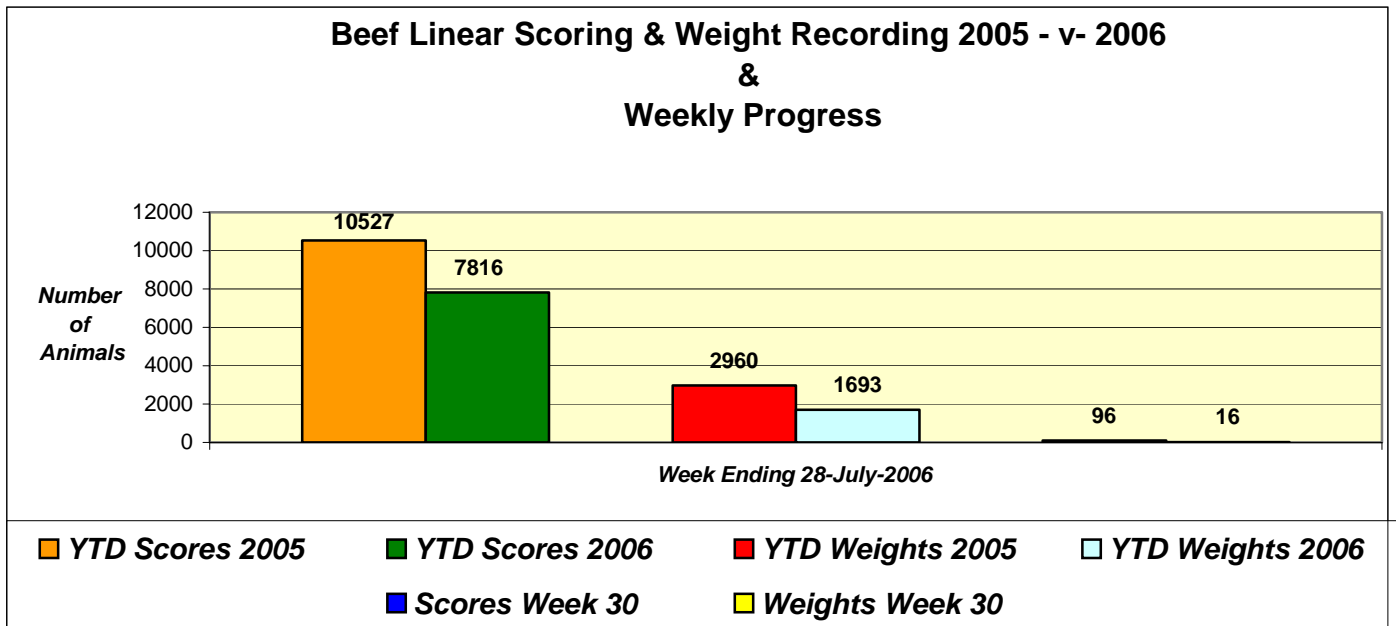
Work on the dairy evaluations is continuing. At this point all relevant files have been sent to Interbull. Work on conversions of fertility data for foreign bulls will be done next week
