2. Review of GROW[®] Call for Submissions

This week we issued a call for submissions for the GROW[®] service review. The review is being conducted in three parts:

- a. **Weights.** To establish a service for recording the growth (weights, dates, condition scores) of pedigree and commercial cattle. This service to be financially attractive to any farmer who is focused on profitable beef production.
- b. **Linears.** To review the traits included in the beef linear scoring service, the ages at which animals are scored and means by which the service is provided. Our goal is to ensure the service provides information that is valued by bull breeders and bull buyers.
- c. **Farm Practices.** To review and identify strategies for ensuring the data recorded in bull breeding and commercial herds can be reliably used in genetic evaluations which are valued by bull buyers.


