


2 ICBF Board Meeting


Topics covered at the ICBF Board meeting on Thursday this week included:

- ✚ The need to ensure that our strategy helps ensure the sustainability of the key ICBF elements of the ICBF infrastructure.
- ✚ The implementation of some further steps around Milk Recording Quality Control, including the use of farm bulk tank data to help ensure that meters on farm are providing accurate indications of milk/solids production.
- ✚ The excellent collaboration between the Milk Recording Organisations, Teagasc, and ICBF in the on-going milk recording promotion activities.
- ✚ Initiatives that are required in conjunction with Industry stakeholders around the Suckler Replacement Index.
- ✚ The sign-off on the Dairy Gene Ireland proposition for 2015.

3 Database



- ✚ The stats above are compiled with the assistance of DAFM AIM systems.
- ✚ BVD test results continue to be received at ICBF and are being processed accordingly. There have been 115,000 results received since January 1st, of which 43,000 have come in the last 7 days. Since the beginning of the voluntary phase in 2012, 5.06 million results have now been received.
- ✚ The graph shows Inseminations recorded on AI Handhelds in 2014 compared with 2015.



4 Herd Plus®

- ✚ EBI reports are now available online. Dairy Cow Reports are currently being printed and dispatched.
- ✚ Stock data is now fully up to date for beef and dairy farmers looking to complete their 2014 profit monitor. All co-op data will be available in dairy profit monitors next week.
- ✚ Dairy HerdPlus customers that wish to run sire advice for the 2015 breeding season can now do so as all December evaluations are up to date.
- ✚ All Co-Op performance reports are now available online and all but the last few batches have been posted. Discussion group reports can also be generated with this data. Group reports can be very useful to advisors at discussion group meetings.
- ✚ Farmers need to ensure that dry off dates are recorded so that milk recording records will be accurate. Annual reports also require that dry off dates are recorded. This can be done through the dry off sheets which were posted out by the milk recording organisations or online through ICBF or a farm software package.
- ✚ As spring calving will have commenced or is about to commence on many dairy and beef farms around the country, it is an appropriate time to remind farmers of the importance of data recording. ICBF acknowledges that spring can be a busy and stressful time for farmers with an endless list of tasks to be done. However, ensuring that data (namely sires and calving ease) is recorded comprehensively and accurately is vital, not only to the work that ICBF does, but also to the development of our Agri-food industry going forward.
- ✚ Better data recording leads to more accurate genetic indexes. This will in turn lead to more informed breeding decisions which will leave more profitable stock on farms and increase output at both farm and processor levels. For this reason, people across the industry that find themselves in regular contact with farmers e.g. agri advisors, breed society representatives, AI company reps & technicians etc. need to constantly stress the importance of recording basic breeding information when registering calves. - ✚ Any farmers that still register calves on the white cards which come with the tags, should be encouraged to switch to an animal events book or, where possible, to register calves online through www.agfood.ie or through a farm software package. The animal events book and online methods allow for much more comprehensive data recording at calf registration. Animal events books can be ordered by calling **1850 625 626**. Online registration can be set up by going to the Department of Agriculture & Food website or contacting your farm software provider.

5 GENÉ IRELAND® Dairy

- ✚ This programme has commenced with an excellent group of bulls this spring.
- ✚ The panel consists of 54 Holstein Friesians, 4 Pure Friesians, 6 Jerseys and 4 crossbreds.
- ✚ Letters were posted to 1,265 herd-owners today.

6 Sheep Ireland

Teagasc Hill sheep conference 2015

- ✚ A great crowd attended this event on Wednesday evening (28th January). One of the speakers, Mr. Sam Wharry, Sheep farmer from Northern Ireland and Chairman of the N.S.U., delivered an excellent presentation which was especially relevant to performance recording and Sheep Ireland. Performance recording of Blackface Mountain sheep is deemed by many as an almost impossible task. Sam admitted that it took a number of years to build enough data to allow him to make useful decisions. Once a number of year's data was captured, he could then make very informed breeding decisions each year. By culling out problem ewes in association with making use of EBVs from Signet, Sam's flock output has made huge

progress in a difficult farming environment. Sam's experience is an example to all Blackface Mountain ram breeders and demonstrates the gains that can be made by collecting performance data and making decisions based on genetic evaluations. This was an excellent event with great messages from all speakers.

Sheep Ireland Board Meeting Thursday 29th January

Topics covered at the Sheep Ireland Board meeting on Thursday this week included:

- ✚ Update reports were presented on LambPlus, MALP, CPT and Ovigen. It was reported that 600 pedigree ram breeders have signed up to LambPlus for 2015, with just 26 breeders choosing to record their data by paper. The benefits of this very high level of online recording will be numerous for both the breeder and the Sheep Ireland office.
- ✚ CPT scanning has been concluded and the results were discussed. An average conception rate to AI of 77.6% was recorded, with a high of 85% down to a low of 67%. The low conception rate on one of the flocks is worrying to the board and a number of possible reasons are currently being explored as described in our update last week.
- ✚ Plans are in place for a round of meetings with our CPT and MALP farmers. Our MALP programme has evolved dramatically since its birth in 2009. From using DNA analysis to assign the parentage of lambs born, through to our current programme of single sire mating, there have been many lessons learned through the years. While the recording practices have changed through the years, the objectives of MALP have always remained the same:
 - To demonstrate the benefits of using high starred LambPlus rams in a commercial setting.
 - To demonstrate to the industry that collecting data on LambPlus rams and performance recording in a commercial sheep flock is possible.
 - To develop a commercial performance recording model that can be used by other sheep farmers.
 - To generate independent, commercial, grass based performance data to contribute to the EuroStar evaluations.
- ✚ All the above objectives contribute to one aim, that is, to provide better EuroStar evaluations to Irish commercial farmers using LambPlus recorded rams. The key is that we do this in a manner that is sustainable into the future.

Sheep Ireland LambPlus ram sale

- ✚ The Sheep Ireland board has decided to go ahead with another LambPlus ram sale for 2015. All the details of this sale are yet to be finalised, but there was an acceptance that the recent year's format, location etc. has been working very well. Final plans for this sale will be included in this update in the coming weeks.






